## The Cause

Conservation leaders across the country are joining forces to support the National Association of Conservation Districts' 509 Capitol Court Campaign—a push to raise \$280,000 to renovate the NACD Headquarters Office in Washington, D.C. Members of the NACD staff will hit the road pedaling in July to further energize the Campaign. Two teams of participants will bike 258 miles in five days—from Ohiopyle, PA, to Washington, D.C., July 14-18, 2008.

## The Goal

The Riders hope to raise \$50,000 in pledges, but...

- If we raise \$100,000 dollars for the ride by July 1, 2008, one officer will ride.
