REVIEW OF SPRING ADVOCACY EFFORTS

Brief discussion of advocacy efforts among states. Washington, Idaho and California all shared that several districts and partners met with policymakers with various levels of success.

In Idaho, dialogue breaching 4 dams on the Snake River is causing some controversy; the state may look to NACD and the region for some support of retaining dams.

REGION PLANNING

Brief discussion on outcomes and key needs identified from annual meeting:

- Better communications between conservation districts, partners, and members across the region, specifically
 to share implementation ideas at landscape levels and to link with key funding agencies
- Identify opportunities to collaborate across the region, specifically on funding and increasing the visibility of conversation districts
- Share information on diversity, equity and inclusion (DEI) and other high level, important topics

In response to a suggestion that the region begin discussion groups to address funding and DEI, board members discussed the **need for a region strategic plan**. The region plan will closely mirror the NACD national-level strategic plan and help drive region activities while providing focus.

Actions:

- 1. Larry Davis previously surveyed some districts and will provide info on their funding sources.
- 2. A small group will meet (Tom Wehri, Doug Rushton, Mae Nakahata and Rick Gomez) to start moving planning forward
- 3. Doug Rushton will connect with Laura Meyer of the Washington State Conservation Commission to share info on the stat's marketing plan for districts.
